I particularly liked the section along NF90H. It is short but sweet as motorbiking trails go.

This is a great loop to base further explorations too. Whether to Stoneman Lake or even as far west as I-17, crossing over to Schnebly Hill Rd and down in to the town of Sedona, you will probably use these trails initially.
