

Parking information

Year round a vehicle must display a permit to park on campus.

Weekdays (after 4:30 p.m.) and weekends all day, commuter and most employee lots are open to all permits unless otherwise posted.

Visitor parking  
(hourly/daily options)

- 15 Minute Parking No Permit Required Stalls are located throughout campus.
- ADA accessible parking is located in proximity to all campus buildings, and if unavailable, parking is permitted in any non-reserved stall with a valid NAU permit.
- Motorcycle parking in designated stalls or white hashed areas not adjacent to ADA stalls or fire hydrants.
